

## ONGOING SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMISSION FOOD DRIVE

The Social Justice Commission is beginning its fifth year of delivering groceries to undocumented families impacted by deportation or seeking asylum from Mexico or Central and South America. Since 2018, we have made deliveries of non-perishable groceries donated by Trinity parishioners along with perishables from Iron Gate to 10-12 families each month. Through this ministry, we seek not only to help put food on the table but also to build relationships and help these families feel warmly welcomed to our community. Our roster of families has gradually evolved over the past four years, with several families having stabilized enough to no longer need food assistance and then quickly being replaced by another family in need.

We gratefully rely on donations of non-perishable food as well as monetary donations to make this program possible. A food drive this fall will help restock our pantry shelves. Please help as you are able. We also need volunteers to make monthly food deliveries and to help sort and assemble donations.
